# Web Developer: E-Learning website for Online Human Rights and Democracy Academy

#### 1. Background

The Cambodian Institute for Democracy (CID) is a non-governmental organization dedicated to promoting human rights, democracy, peace and inclusive development in Cambodia. As part of our mission, we are launching an Online Human Rights and Democracy Academy aimed at providing accessible, high-quality education on these critical topics. To facilitate this, CID seeks a skilled web developer to design and develop a user-friendly, secure, and scalable e-learning website.

# 2. Objective

The primary objective of this project is to design and develop an e-learning website that provides online courses on human rights and democracy. The website should be intuitive, interactive, and equipped with the necessary tools to support effective learning and engagement for users.

#### 3. Scope of Work

The web developer will be responsible for the following tasks:

- Website Design and Development:
  - Design a visually appealing, user-friendly, and responsive e-learning website.
  - Develop a custom Content Management System (CMS) or integrate an existing LMS (e.g., Moodle, LearnDash) to manage course content, users, and other functionalities.
  - Ensure the website is fully accessible and mobile-friendly.

# • E-Learning Features:

- Develop modules for course registration, user profiles, and course management.
- o Implement multimedia support (video, audio, text) for course materials.
- Create an interactive user interface for quizzes, assignments, and discussions.
- Develop tracking and reporting tools for user progress and course completion.
- Security and Data Protection:
  - Implement robust security measures to protect user data and course content.
  - Ensure the website complies with data protection regulations.
  - Set up secure login and authentication processes.

### • Integration and Compatibility:

- Integrate the website with payment gateways for course fees.
- Ensure compatibility with popular web browsers and devices.
- Implement features for social media sharing and communication.

# • Testing and Quality Assurance:

- Conduct thorough testing of the website to identify and fix bugs.
- Ensure website performance is optimized for speed and user experience.
- Provide support for beta testing and user feedback integration.

- 3. Final E-Learning Website: Fully functional website with all specified features.
- 4. User Manual and Training: Comprehensive documentation and training session for CID staff.
- 5. Maintenance Plan: A plan for ongoing maintenance and updates.

- 3) Have a broad knowledge of current web development technologies and design tools in the field, and new software and other web programming languages and programs.
- 4) Have excellent knowledge of current trends in graphic design web sites, including online video publishing and social media networking
- 5) Demonstrate the ability to create innovative and visually appealing designs.
- 6) Knowledge of web security best practices.
- 7) Excellent problem-solving skills and attention to detail.
- 8) Ability to meet deadlines and work independently.

- 1) Technical Expertise: Experience and qualifications related to the project.
- 2) **Quality of Proposal:** Clarity, feasibility, and innovation in the proposed approach.
- 3) Cost-effectiveness: Alignment of proposed costs with the project's budget.
- 4) **References and Portfolio:** Quality and relevance of previous work.
